

## Training Fees for Full-time Technical Diploma Courses for Academic Year 2024 (AY2024)

### For existing students admitted in AY2023 under Skills Future Mid-Career Enhanced Subsidy

ITE has adopted a **cohort-based fee structure** for full-time *Nitec*, *Higher Nitec* and Technical Diploma courses. Under the structure, a student's tuition fee will remain unchanged for the entire duration of the course. With this, students will have greater certainty regarding the tuition fee and can better plan the financing of their studies.

#### Note:

- The above training fees apply to existing students admitted to Technical Diploma courses under Skills Future Mid-Career Enhanced Subsidy in the AY2023 intake. (For new students admitted in AY2024 under Skills Future Mid-Career Enhanced Subsidy, MOE will advise separately whether it is applicable for 2024 intake.)
- One term is for a duration of six months.
- Fee rates are inclusive of GST or after GST subsidy.
- Students are required to pay their term fees for all terms by the stipulated dates in order to remain in their course of study. For subsequent terms, students are required to pay their fees through PSEA or GIRO (if you are not paying using PSEA, or your PSEA balance is insufficient for all terms in the course of study).
- Tuition Grant is provided to all eligible full-time Technical Diploma course students by the Government of Singapore, through the Ministry of Education (MOE), to subsidise their tertiary education. Technical Diploma students who are eligible for and accept the Tuition Grant will pay subsidised Tuition Fee. Those who are not eligible for or do not accept the Tuition Grant will have to pay the non-subsidised Tuition Fee, inclusive of 9% GST. - Students who were previously enrolled in Institute of Technical Education (Technical Diploma courses), Institutions of Higher Learning (IHLs) such as National University of Singapore, Nanyang Technological University, Singapore Institute of Technology, Singapore Management University, Singapore University of Social Sciences, Singapore University of Technology & Design, Nanyang Polytechnic, Ngee Ann Polytechnic, Republic Polytechnic, Singapore Polytechnic and Temasek Polytechnic, or the Arts Institutions such as Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts and LASALLE College of the Arts, may not be eligible for the MOE Tuition Grant and may have to pay non-subsidised Tuition Fees. Students are advised to check with MOE on their eligibility for Tuition Grant.
