For designing a 3D prototype of a plane with a hybrid engine, a team of three ITE students won the Global Grand Prize at the Aviation Innovation Competition organised by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO).

Titled "Low Emission Commercial Aircraft", the prototype by Steven s/o Muthukumar, Nicole Ng Shi Ya and Michael Cham Teik Hoe was designed to reduce aircraft fuel consumption.

Besides designing the prototype, they also had to submit a business case summary which describes why their solution should attract investment and how it can be cost-effectively produced.

Mr Khaw Boon Wan, Minister for Transport, presented the Award to the team at ITE College Central on 10 October 2019.

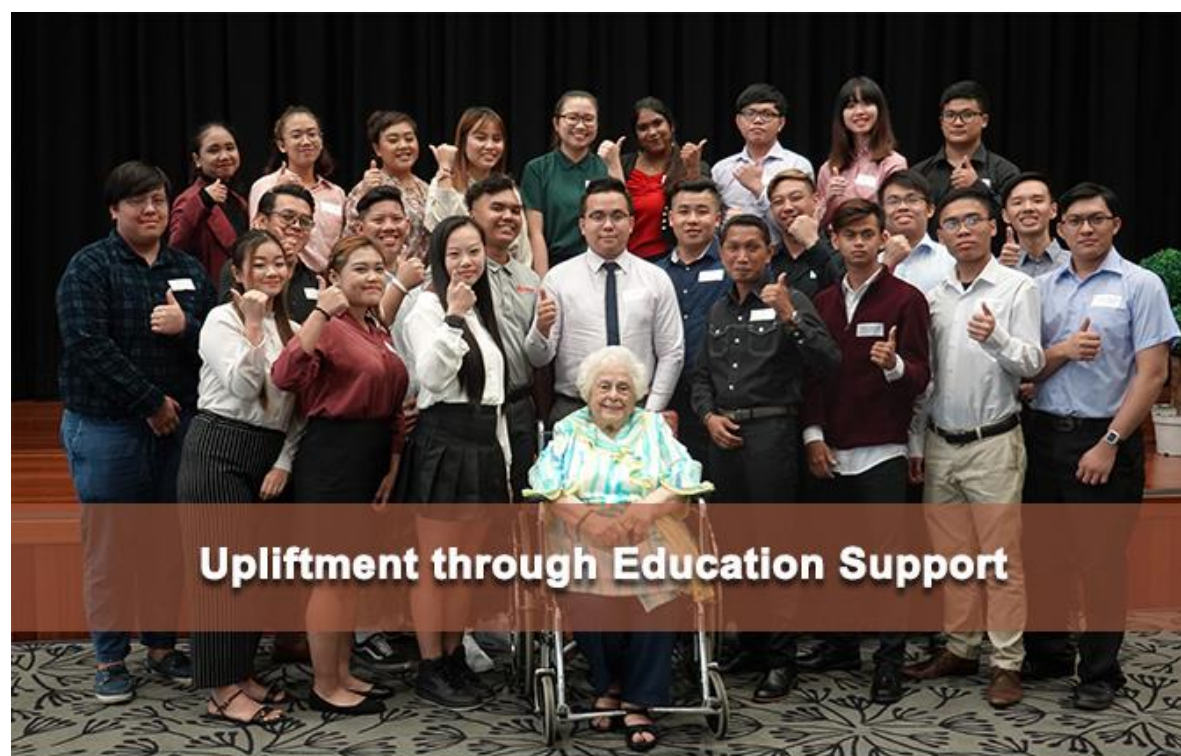
Organised by the Health Promotion Board, the Singapore HEALTH Award recognises organisations with strong commitment to promoting workplace health.
